UCL IOE Taught Postgraduate Regulations 2016-17

Effective from 1 September 2016 for new and continuing students.

1.1.1 Introduction

- 1 These Regulations govern the conduct and award of Master's Degrees, Postgraduate Diplomas and Certificates and Professional Diplomas and Certificates.
- 2 These Regulations are made subject to the *UCL Academic Manual*, the *IOE Assessment Regulations for Students 2016-17* and any other appropriate regulations, policies or procedures of UCL.
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- 2 Where appropriate, a PGCE or other approved teaching qualification, and/or relevant professional experience, may be required in addition to one or more of the Standard UCL Entry Requirements defined in the *UCL Academic Manual, Chapter 1: Admissions, Registration and Student Conduct*.



Duration of Programme

- 1 The duration of a programme of study leading to each qualification is defined in the *UCL Academic Manual, Chapter 2: Qualifications and Credit Framework*.

1.1.7 Attendance

- 1 The attendance requirements for UCL students are defined in the *UCL Academic Manual, Chapter 1: Admissions, Registration and Student Conduct*.

1.1.8 Assessment

- 1 In order to qualify for a Master's degree or a Postgraduate Diploma/Certificate award, a candidate must satisfy the examiners that s/he has attained a satisfactory standard in the taught elements/courses of the approved programme of study.
- 2 The timing of the assessment of each element of a Master's degree programme shall be in accordance with published schedules.
