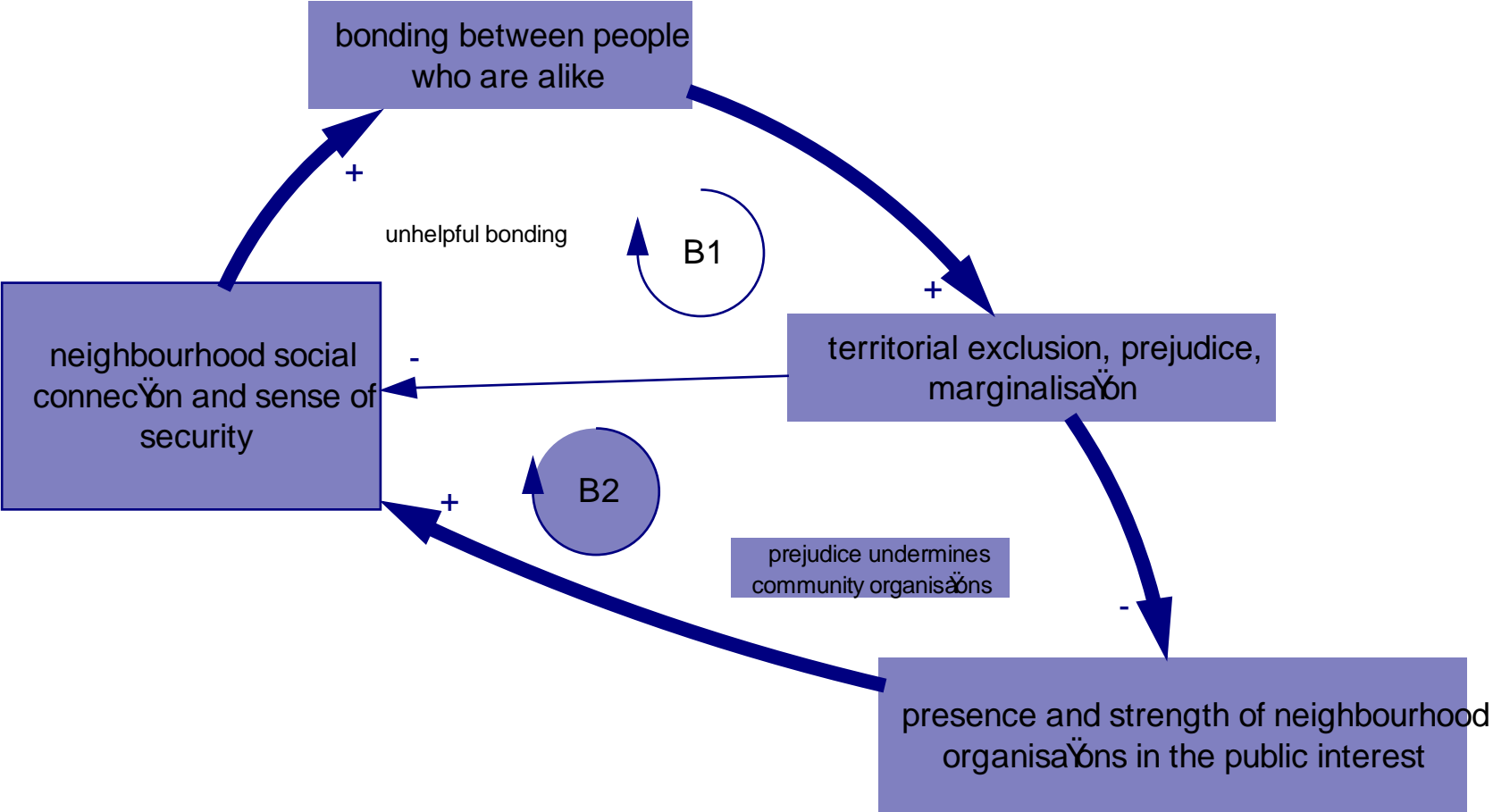
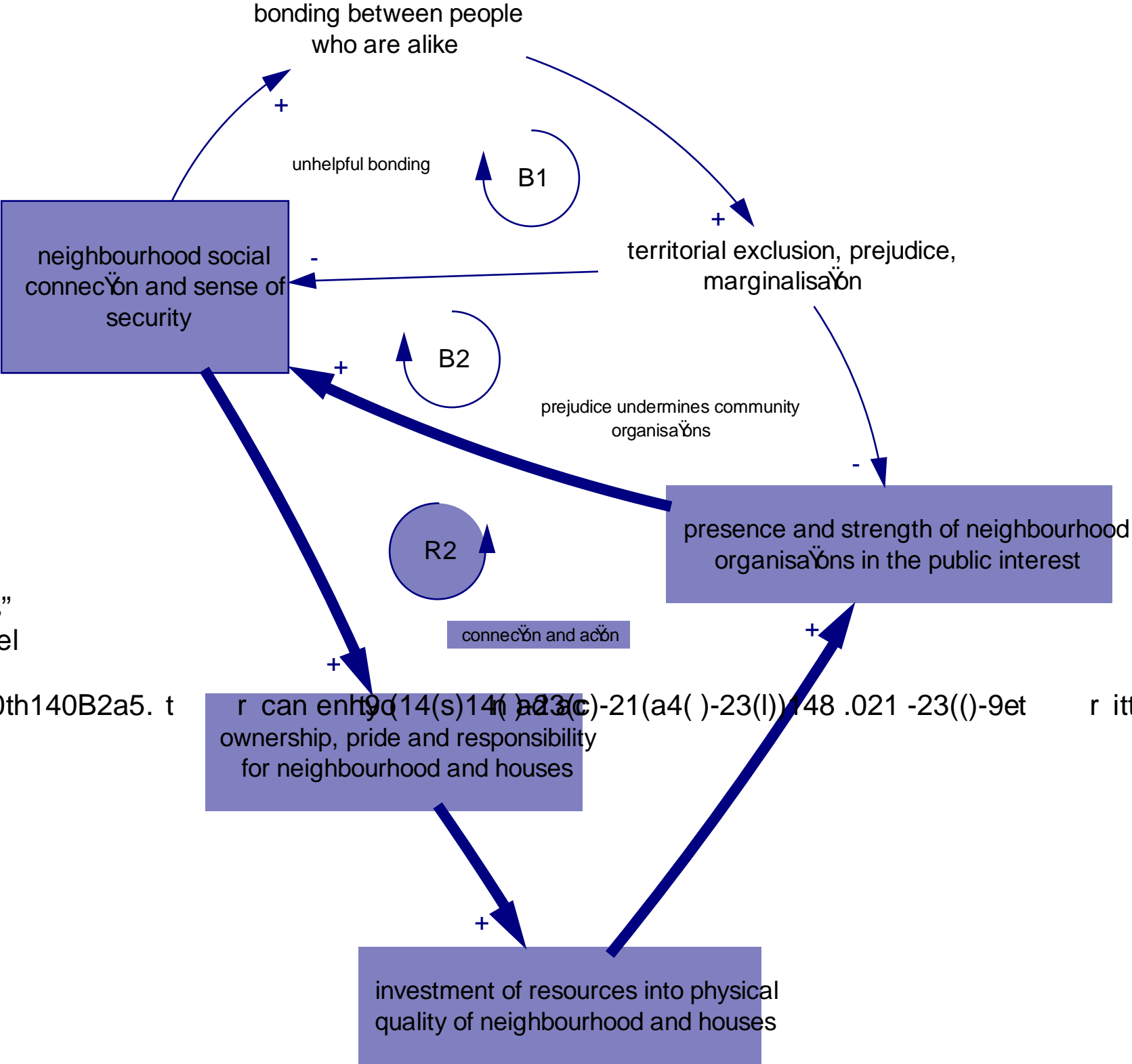


*B1 unhelpful bonding: increasing social capital can lead to stronger bonds between people who are alike in ethnicity or socioeconomic status. In turn this can lead to territorial exclusion, prejudice and marginalisation of other groups. This can then undermine further improvements in local social connect on and sense of security.*



R2 connection and action: Stakeholders proposed that improving the physical quality of neighbourhoods (including quality of green space and “third spaces” or other places where locals could meet) leads to greater neighbourhood-level social connections – either directly or through longer tenure. In turn, these connections can enhance community capacity to take action
