

5.3 The President of the UCL Union Music Society shall be a member of the Committee *ex officio*, counting as one of the Ordinary members in 5.1 above. If the President is unable to attend a meeting of the Committee, he/she may nominate another member of the UCL Union Music Society's Committee to attend that meeting on his/her behalf.

authorised deputy (as under 6.3 above) shall normally take over as Acting Chair, with all the powers and responsibilities of the Chair, until the next Annual General Meeting, when a new Chair shall be elected. The Acting Chair shall be eligible to stand for election as Chair. The Annual General Meeting shall have the discretion to elect the Acting Chair to the post of Chair either for the usual period of three years, or for a shorter period, taking account of the length of time that the Acting Chair has been in post.

6.11 In the event that the Chair is expected to be unable to fulfil his/her duties for a significant period of time, but is expected to be able to resume the post in the foreseeable future, an authorised deputy shall normally, with the agreement of the Committee, take over as Acting Chair, with all the powers and responsibilities of the Chair, for that period.

6.12 In the event that the Secretary or Treasurer is unable to continue in post, an authorised deputy (when one has already been elected as under 6.3 above) shall normally take over as Acting Secretary or Acting Treasurer, with all the powers and responsibilities of the Secretary or Treasurer, until the next Annual General Meeting, when a new Secretary or Treasurer shall be elected. When there is no authorised deputy elected as under 6.3 above, the Committee shall elect a deputy to act in the absence of the Secretary or Treasurer.
