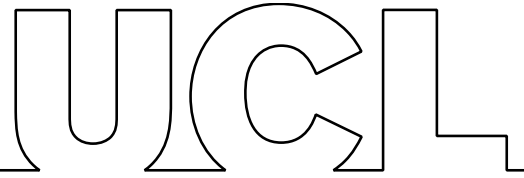
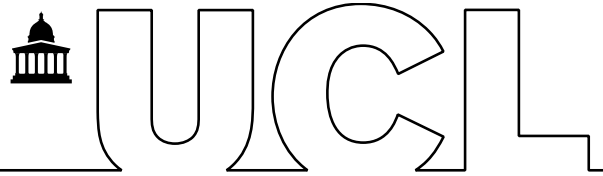




UCL



Article 89(1) of the GDPR states that processing for archiving purposes in the public interest, scientific or historical research purposes or statistical purposes, must be subject to appropriate safeguards



- Article 21(1) (GDPR objections to processing).

Please note that these exemptions can only be relied upon to the extent that the application of the above GDPR provisions would seriously impair the achievement of specific research purposes.

You must contact the data protection team immediately if you receive any requests from data subjects wishing to exercise their rights.

E. Summary of appropriate safeguards to be implemented by UCL researchers

Taking into account the legislative provisions set out above, UCL researchers must implement the following 'appropriate safeguards' when carrying out research involving the processing of special category information or personal data relating to criminal convictions or offences:
