getting a BSc. MSc's (even at UCL) have to be applied for via the normal application process, not via portico.

(iv) If you are thinking about transferring to the MSci, you need to think realistically about which modules you would take and which projects you might do in Year 4, given the modules you have taken. Information can be found on the maths webpage. You should also think if the fourth year of the MSci is really what you wish to do - although ideal for some students, it is not suitable for all and is significantly harder than Year 3. Note points the above: also, if you end Year 3 with a mark in the 60 - 65% range you are advised to take the BSc and not to do Year 4.

E. How to apply to transfer

- (i) If you are thinking about transferring, you could start by discussing it with your personal tutor (or another member of staff).
- (ii) Please think about the points from C or D above.
- (iii) If you then wish to transfer, please discuss with me first and then apply through C2RS via your portico account. (C2RS = Change to registration status).
